We have liaised with Hyde and Lambeth Council to make sure our most vulnerable residents have not been neglected; and lobbied Hyde's senior management seeking assurances that rent arrears are treated sympathetically and nobody loses the roof over their heads during such a horrendous time.

But we have missed hearing about problems first hand and getting feedback from everyone. We have undoubtedly missed out on some issues.
